Speaker recounts journey

Anthony Cohen awed the Worsham Theater crowd last night with stories from his personal experiences tracing the Underground Railroad.

Cohen began his journey last May in Sandy Springs, Md. ending at the Howard-Holland family reunion, descendants of a refugee slave family, in Ambersburg, Ontario two months later.

Now his journey takes him from elementary schools to college campuses to government agencies in an effort to educate the public about the Underground Railroad.

"He has turned, what I and

the puone ground Railroad.

"He has turned, what I and many others thought, a piece of African-American history into just American history," said Jon Hall, co-chairman of the Student

Activities Board Multicultural Committee.

During the presentation, Cohen said, "I want to show people that this is a very diverse piece of history full of legend and lore involving many different races and beliefs."

Although not on the ruin from slave hunters, Cohen faced many obstacles during his trek of the historical trail.

He covered the 1,200-mile trip by foot, train and boat, sometimes walking up to 25 miles a day.

Cohen's unique approach to the journey offered interaction with people via the World Wide Web.

"I had a web page where people could e-mail me, and offer me any further information regarding my quest," the 33-year-old historian said.

Cohen hopes to publish a book from excerpts of a diary he kept while traveling.

A documentary of the journey is also expected, which Cohen services from ill help sear at national foundation for the Underground Railroad.

Thrush makes auspicious label debut

If simplicity served as a goal for this Canadian foursome when entering the studio, then they most certainly left successful. Sweet Homewrecker is the first major label release for Thrush Hermit, a power polyfrock group from Halifax, Nova Scotta.

Women enter SEC tourney play

One could speculate that nine squads have something to play for in the Southeastern Conference Women's Basketball Tournament this weekend in Chattanooga, Tenn.

Some teams like Georgia and Alabama are playing for seeds in the upcoming NCAA Tournament. Then there are the proverbial bubble teams like Arkansas, Ole Miss, and Auburn who need a good showing.

Then there's UK (8-18, 2-9). The Wildats would need a miracle run through the SEC Tournament to advance to the NCAA Tournament.

Tenth-seeded UK will take on 7th-seeded Arkansas (17-9, 5-7) in the first round of the SEC Tourney at 3 p.m.

Arkansas head coach Cary Blair said, "We're a bubble team. We need to win against Kentucky to make it hard for the committee and that's the number one thing.

"If we don't make the NCAA Tournament, we may be the only team in the history of men's or women's basketball that's been in the Top 25 in both polls all year and not make the NCAA Tournament."

Currently ranked No. 23, Arkanasa has fallen on hard times. The Lady Razorbacks have lost 5-of-7 to put their NCAA hopes up for grabs.

UK and Arkanasa met each other in January in Fayetteville. Arkanasa gave the Cats an 88-55 drubbing.

"Kentucky is playing very well right now," Blair said of UK, losers of six of their last seven. "We handled them pretty easy in Fayetteville. That could be in our favor or it could work against us. Obviously we cannot overlook anyone."

The Wildcats enter the SEC Tournament on a modest one-game winning streak. UK won its conference closer against South Carolina to earn the 10th seed in the tournament.

"I want my team to play like they did last Saturday night against South Carolina," said UK head coach Bernadette Mattox. "They executed, they played great defense and they stracked right from the beginning of the game."


