Parties welcome students to UK

Students will have an opportunity to relieve tension and panic before the fall semester begins at the annual Student Center Spectacular.

Approximately 2,000 new and transfer students are expected to attend the Student Center Spectacular on Sunday evening. A total of 17 different events were organized by the Student Activities Board and SGA.

Alex Goodman, Indoor Activities chairperson for SAB, helped line up the event this year, which includes three music groups, a comedian and a hypnotist.

The Student Center Spectacular is one of the best ways to introduce new students and transfers to the large amount of different activities on campus," said Edward Marshall, program assistant for SAB.

A snake and reptile exhibit are among the new additions to this year's Spectacular. The exhibit will allow students to handle the snakes and reptiles.

Dancers will have two opportunities to show their skills. A professional country line dancer will be present to teach students how to boot stomp and other line dances. International students

will wear traditional clothes to teach folk dancing to any interested student.

Gamblers are invited to a Monte Carlo Casino Night which will feature 23 different games such as craps and blackjack. The games will be played with fake money and no prizes will be given for winning.

However, door prizes will be given throughout the evening.

The next night, the Student Government and Residence Hall Associations have planned the first annual "Back to School Bash."

The event is open to all students, faculty and staff.

Last spring, the Freshman Representative Counsel planned an "End of School Bash," but rain washed it out.

SGA summer Senate approved funding to reschedule the event for Monday.

"We're banking on the weather, because

there really is no way

to have an alternate site," said SGA president Alan Ajia.

Barring inclement weather, the outdoor event will feature a live band, open basketball and sand volleyball.

UK Food Services will sell food and drinks. Radio station 103 will have a remote live broadcast from Haggan Hall Field.

Add/Drop hints simplify class schedule changes

UK-VIP is relatively easy to use, but every once in a while, things don't work out as planned and a number of questions emerge. Here is a guide to help you through this year's Add/Drop.

►Add/Drop opens on Aug. 27 at 7 a.m. and closes on Sept. 4 at 8 p.m.

▼If you forget your PAC number, go to Student Records, 10 Funkhouser, with a picture ID. Your PAC cannot be released over the telephone or without a photo ID.

▼Phones in the registrar's office are not answered faster than other calls. The calls are taken in the order in which they are received.

▼The conditional drop/add function does not allow a student to drop a course until the student successfully adds a replacement course.

▼If a student adds a new course, the system confirms by repeating the course prefix, course number and section number of the course they have added, followed by the course prefix, course number and section number of the course the

student has dropped.

▼UK-VIP allows a student to check open sections of a course against courses, a person is currently enrolled in and alerts that student to open sections that fit into their schedule.

▼If a class is closed, go to the class for the first couple of days. Some students enrolled in the class may drop it in the first few days. If no one drops the class, a student may be able to get an override from the professor.

▼A student can pick up a printed schedule by presenting a phone ID in the Registrar's Office, or by going to any microcomputer lab.

▼Overlapping schedules is possible, but not through UK-VIP. If you receive permission to register in two courses that have overlapping meeting patterns, go to 5 or 6 Funkhouser Building your registration or Add/Drop window.

▼If you have questions, consult the fall registration book.

For further questions, students can call the Registration Help Line at 257-7173. Help is available Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

While most students are making their UK debut or return trip, some have had their summers short and have been on campus for the past week. Women participating in sorority recruitment and members of the marching band have gotten a head start on their semester while putting in long hours with their organizations.

Since Sunday, marching band members have spent their days in the hot sun on Stoll Field near the Student Center, learning formations and practicing music for their first show coming up Aug. 31 at the UK-UL football game.

Richard Clary, director of bands, said the 245 band members will prepare three shows for this year's season, the first one is a "traditional patriotic show featuring a gigantic American flag." The other two shows they will learn through the remainder of the season will be music from the musical "Grease" and a fantasy show with a space theme.

Clary said it takes about a week to learn the formations and music for each

show.

"They'll have the first show on the field by the end of the week," Clary said.

Junior Margaret Dittinger, color guard squad leader, said the band has been working daily from 8:30 in the morning until 9 at night. Once classes begin, rehearsal time will be reduced to six hours per week.

Dittinger said they had a week less to prepare this year since the football season is beginning earlier, but they will be ready for the opening game.

Coming back to campus

a week early for days of rehearsal hasn't bothered Dittinger even though it shortened her summer.

"Band is a great bonding experience, especially for freshmen," she said. "You have to have people if you spend 12 hours a day with them."

While the band was marching, 623 women were also participating in sorority recruitment week.

Dean Susan West, sorority adviser, said the process began last Saturday and ends with bid day today. The number of women involved is up from the 534 who went through last year.

West said part of the increase is due to the greater promotional work done by the Panhellenic Council this year and the new format for recruitment.

"One of the goals of Panhellenic is to change the image of sorority life," West said. The process is no longer called "rush," but has been changed to "recruitment week," West said. She said the process has become more relaxed and less formal.

This year, women were allowed to wear casual clothing for the first three rounds instead of dressing up.

"There is more emphasis on community service than entertainment," West said. "They are given more information about the chapter."

When the recruitment process ends with today's bid day, each of the 13 sororities will offer membership to a maximum of 38 women, West said. It is then up to the women whether or not they join the organization they have been invited to.

Nancy Baldwin, a sophomore transfer student, who has been participating in the recruitment week said she enjoyed the process because of the people she met.

"I'm new to UK. I didn't know anyone," Baldwin said.

Kelly O'Bryan, a freshman, said it had been a fun week but that it was hard to choose preferences.

"It gets stressful if you don't get invited back to where you wanted," O'Bryan said. "I've already cut them down."

West said women who did not participate in formal recruitment but are still interested in sorority life can register for open recruitment beginning Monday at 575 Patterson Office Tower.

UK-VIP has the open line for class registration

It's one of those technological advances that makes our lives easier. Although we don't realize it, we save time and escape hassles every time we do it.

Just ask any student who endured Add/Drop before the new system was installed in the 1993 fall semester. They are counting their blessings.

When it comes to registering, adding and dropping classes, UK's Voice Information Processing Network, commonly known as UK-VIP, has brought relief to the campus.

"(VIP's) a lot easier than standing in line," said Ava Beckett, a secondary Spanish senior. "As far as registering — you can do it in five minutes and be done."

Although registering has been done by computers for years, students used to have to wait in line

to speak directly with a staff member who entered the information at a computer terminal.

Now, students use the telephone to communicate with a box located in McVey Hall that contains the actual VIP operating system.

VIP uses the Student Information System (SIS) to retrieve the information it needs to work correctly.

For example, when your VIP window opens is based on your social security number and student status. The VIP system obtains the information from SIS.

This convenient connection can present a problem, however.

"If SIS goes down, then VIP will not function either," said Michelle Nordin, director of registration.

But this doesn't happen often.

As a matter of fact, it has only happened once in the month that Nordin has held this position, and it was only down for a few minutes.

"It functions pretty well, all the time," she said. "(VIP) is so much better. We're constantly looking for ways to improve the system — make things easier on students."

nals when it is time to register. Since there are 62 lines, it has not been a major problem, but it can be frustrating for students who get a busy signal.

Nordin advises that students not use automatic busy dial, any kind of radial or cordless phones. These can make it harder to get through. In addition, she recommends doing your homework to reduce VIP-stress for both yourself and the Registrar's office.

"The best advice I can give for using VIP is read the front of the schedule book," she said. "And then if they find that they're having problems, we're here to help Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m."

The phone number is 257-7173. For general questions, to pick up a schedule, change your address or get a campus map, an information desk will be in the lobby of the Funkhouser Building Monday through Friday.

Student tickets for Louisville game to be distributed Monday morning

Student ticket distribution for the Louisville football game begins at 9 a.m. Monday at the ticket windows in front of Memorial Coliseum.

The Cards will kickoff their season at Commonwealth Stadium against their archrivals on Saturday, Aug. 31, at 6:30 p.m. ESPN2 will televise the game live nationally.

Students can buy tickets at the same location until 4 p.m. each day next week. UK Director of Administrative Services Rodney Stiles said that "approximately 10,000 tickets" will be set aside for student distribution.

For the first time in school his-

tory, it will cost UK students \$5 for a football ticket. Prior to this season, students received their tickets free; however, they did have to pay for their men's basketball tickets.

In order to receive a ticket, students must present their UK ID and the \$5 fee to the person at the ticket window.

Students must also be full-time (12 credit hours undergraduate, nine hours graduate). The ID will be scanned to make sure the individual is a full-time student. They will then give the student their ticket.

Students are permitted to buy no more than two tickets each. If you want to sit next to someone, you can bring their ID and purchase two tickets.

Last year's game against the Cardinals was the second largest crowd in the history of Commonwealth Stadium, as 58,967 watched U of L gain its first-ever win over the Cards.

In 1994, the record crowd in the history of the stadium, 39,162, came out to watch UK top the Cards 20-14, in the first meeting between the two intrastate rivals in 70 years.

Students camped out the night before the first ticket distribution for the 1994 game, forcing UK officials to distribute control cards so that people could go home and not lose their spot in line.

Stiles said that the 1994 game against U of L was sold out by the Wednesday before the game.

Last year, a few students started to line up around the windows at about 6 a.m., but the numbers were down from the previous year. In fact, there were still tickets available on game day,

although the game was eventually a sellout.

Stiles said students have never bought all the available tickets through distribution. He said that generally students buy "about 3,000 through distribution, the rest sell as guest tickets."

Guest tickets, if there are any available after Monday's distribution, will go on sale Tuesday. Sideline seats cost \$20, endzone seats cost \$16.

Cats want more from less in '96

Less is more.

So says head coach Fran Ralston-Flory about the 1996 UK volleyball squad.

Less refers to the graduation losses of All-Southeastern Conference performers Molly Dreisbach and Mara Egglitz, who together contributed to nearly 50 percent of the team's offensive output last year on a team that finished 10-18 overall, 7-7 in the SEC.

More refers to the gains the team has made in making up for that.

"Loosing players like Molly and Mara is certainly not a good thing," Ralston-Flory conceded. "But their departure allows us to expand our game plan and include more players in our offense - a move that gives us a more balanced attack."

And including players is exactly what Ralston-Flory is doing. In fact, with so many players to choose from, she said it will be difficult to nail down the starting lineup.

"At this point, Gina Heustis is the only for sure starter," Ralston-Flory said. "After that, each position is up-for-grabs."

Houston, an outside hitter from Louisville, had a solid 1995 season - smashing 3.3 kills per game and playing in 101 games, second - most on last year's team. In addition to Heustis, junior outside hitter Cynthia Dozier figures to be in the mix for a starting position as well. She returns from last season in which, despite limited playing time, she averaged 3.3 kills per game.

For the 1996 season, the coaching staff decided to employ a new recruiting philosophy. Rather than recruit the pure athletes as they were in the past, the staff instead pursued players with more specialized skills.

"We wanted girls that really

understood the game of volleyball," Ralston-Flory said. "We were able to recruit four players who have both athleticism and a strong background in the fundamentals of this sport."

Perhaps most indicative of that new philosophy is freshman Jaclyn Homan of St. Henry, Ohio. Homan had an impressive high school career that culminated with her perfecting a quad during her senior year that will surely render a game the entire season, a seemingly impossible feat.

A team wins a volleyball match when they are the first to win three games, similar to the game-set relationship in tennis.

When considering the 1996 team, it could be labeled a "rebirth," a year that will thrust several young and untested players into key roles.

However, the year will be a birth of other sorts as well — Ralston-Flory is due to give birth on Oct. 23. Although the coach is excited about the newest addition to the family, she isn't intending to let it get in the way of her coaching.

"I am going to continue to coach as long as I possibly can," said the former All-Southeastern Conference player at Texas. "After she's born, I am going back with the team - she can sit in the stands and watch the matches with her daddy."

The Student Group Health Insurance Plan for 1996-97 continues with Mega Life and Health Insurance Company. Because of recent publicity regarding Kentucky House Bill 250 and how it affects health insurance, it is important to note the exemption of student insurance from health care reform in accordance with Kentucky Senate Bill 343. The Student Group Health Insurance Plan is legal to sell in the state of Kentucky. We are also pleased to inform you that while benefits have been improved, the annual premium has been reduced. The following information will assist you in understanding the plan if you are enrolling for the first time. If you are already enrolled, this will serve as a reminder.

Plan Benefits: This is a traditional insurance plan with two benefit options. You may choose to use the University Hospital, Kentucky Hospital, Kentucky Medical Services, or Highlands Regional Hospital (Prestonsburg, KY). Preferred Providers and receive a higher benefit. Cost containment arrangements have been negotiated with these facilities to provide savings to students. The plan covers inpatient, outpatient, accident/illness, and surgery. Always read the "exclusions and limitations" of the policy so you are familiar with items not covered, as well as benefit limits listed under the Basic Medical Expense Benefits.

Major Medical coverage to extend the maximum benefit per condition from \$50,000 to \$100,000 may be purchased for an additional premium. This extended benefit must be purchased when a student enrolls in the plan—it CANNOT be added after initial enrollment during a calendar year.






