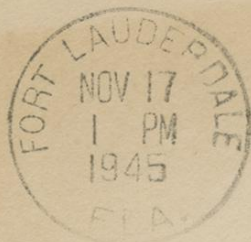

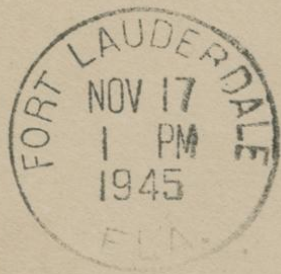

of your self.

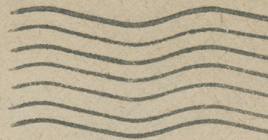
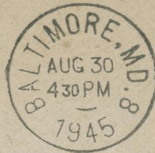
Marlene wanted when you

at the present prices. So, I may as well close the acct.

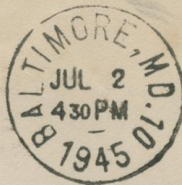
Say, you mention in your letter that you

form

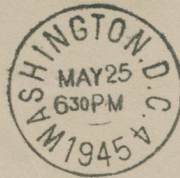
They think it come from
