i could not be discharged i was

fit for duty so i think after a little
time i shall have my discharge yet
i mean to try hard for it any how
i hope you wont visit your self because
i have very easy times i dont cook
any more the men have build Log
houses fire in sum and ten in others
and they cook them selves i doer
nothing but draw the racking
and give them to the men i will
