Sir.

As it will be impossible to poll the vote of all the Kentucky Soldiers now encamped near Lexington, at the said voting precincts in the city. It is proposed to divide their vote as nearly equal as practicable between the different precincts in the vicinity.

In order that the division may be made so as not to interfere with the polling of the Citizen vote, a report will be at once made and forwarded to these Head Quarters, giving, as near as possible, the number of qualified voters in each Regiment who desire to exercise the rights of suffrage at the Approaching Presidential Election.

Upon receipt of these reports, the voting place of each Regiment will be announced in orders.
