William E. Spencer died at 2 A.M. Sept. 26, 1862 at
Helena, Ark. Brought to Memphis and buried there.

He was in his twentieth year

William E. Spencer was the son of Elisha Spencer,
an early pioneer of Appleton, after whom Spencer
Street was named. The old Spencer homestead stood
where the present plant of the Consolidated Bridger
Coop Milk plant on Spencer Street now stands. Elisha
Spencer was the grandfather of the late R. K. Wolter of
Appleton
