Louisville, Sept 28th 1862

Dear Uncle
 It is
 with pleasure that I enjoy a
 few of my unoccupying moments
 to inform that I enjoy good
 health and am hoping this
 may reach you in the same
 conditions of happiness since
 my last we had a long
 and tedious march through
 Tennessee & Kentucky marching
 and countermarching after
 the Rebels now for a month
 we followed them for 200
 miles and not caught
 all of them yet - on the
 march from Bowling Green
 to this place we took 3,000
