

Dear Brother

December 3. 1859

The sale is over for the present we have sold every thing except four negroes one was taken sick few days before the sale Letty is her name she is well now the other three were hired out they will be at home at the end of the year and will be sold the first day of January next 1860 I will tell you their names Harry Festus Edward and Letty these four are not sold I wish you to be here when they are sold do come to see me I would be glad to see you I now write which were sold and the prices they brought Dabney sold for \$1050:00 Sarah sold for \$1450:00 Stapleton sold for \$935:00 James sold for \$930:00 Mary and her youngest child sold for \$655:00 Amy sold for \$655:00 Alace sold for \$530:00 Agga sold for \$25:00 Minny we give fifteen Dollars to William to take her and maintain her for life Paddy I took her for twenty Dollars to maintain for life hard Bargain at that, now comes your negroes Caroline and minor Caroline sold for \$32:25 minor sold for \$1070:00 this money is in Bank for you which I will send when it
