Dear Brother
we received your letter about
two weeks ago and was glad to
hear that you was enjoying good
health your letter found us
as well as usual well Lewis
we are having some awful hot
weather just now after you left
here we had quite a spell of
wet weather and then it came
off dry and has been dry and
hot ever since the dry hot weather
is going to injure the crops very
much I cut my hay last
week finished stacking yesterday
had about 10 tons of splended
hay our grain will be fit to
commence to cut this week
Mr Morse cut my hay and is
