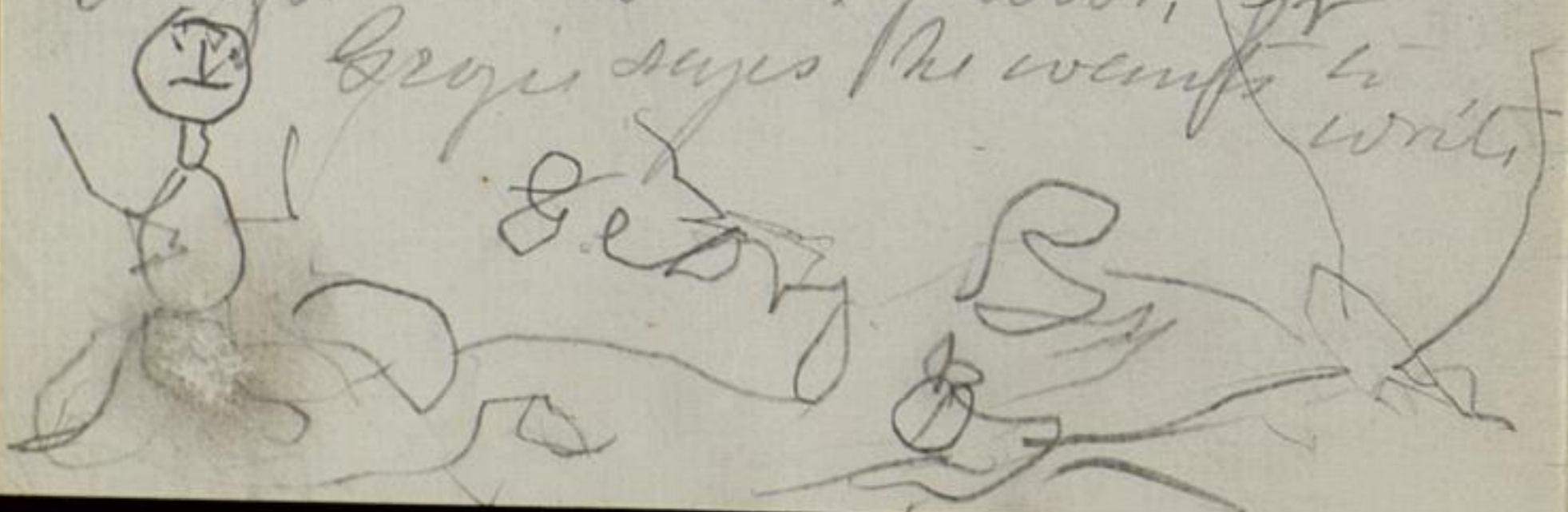


Snowdown then held up and the

Bridport Nov 10<sup>th</sup> 1868

we sent letter to you a week  
 ago last Monday & two papers  
 Election day It plowed all day  
 on Monday & Tuesday in the forenoon  
 then went to town & called  
 for Brent (had a shot at  
 the old Bobs) then had to come  
 home & thresh some Oats for  
 the Ponies Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> I went  
 down & finished plowing this  
 forenoon & brought up the plow  
 then in the afternoon I drove  
 some wood for George then  
 chummed before supper done the  
 chowrs &c. Ellen was here this  
 afternoon Thursday Nov 5<sup>th</sup> Hamner  
 come helped me break the house  
 & we threshed a few more Oats &  
 in the afternoon I plowed the little  
 piece east of the barn below the  
 rain all forenoon
