I received two letters from you yesterday and received them being an Army back sack with the clothes and fives again, and I do not feel well enough this morning to write much I shall send with this a journal, we have been quite a while here but it did not amount to any thing here I have a letter from Harriet, yesterday she has received her husband and her little boy, the weather is very warm here now, my head feels too bad to write much so I will quit hoping I shall be able to write more soon
