were were some 4 or 5 days last month. I do not
expect you will under stand much about it I thought
I would send it home. I shall all so send you a little
a count I cut from a New York paper about the 8th of
while they were at Barber's Cross Roads on the 25th of May
or the night of the 25th but we only got 1 Prisoner in
steer of 5. and as to the attack that the Rebels made on
us that night did not amount to much as they only
fired a few times on our Pickets just enough to wake us
up once or twice and now if the ruff catches on the other
side please you any I shall be glad of it if not it will
not make much difference as when I washed it out I had
nothing else to do so I shall not lose any thing by it any
way. and I do not think you will make a great sight
out of it.
