Dear Lieutenant:

I hope you arrived
all safe at Pulaski but I have
not yet heard from you.

I wish you to write to
me what you think of or what you
can ascertain in regard to a general
stock of dry goods at Pulaski or
any place else down in Dixie.

Before I can settle
my account with the government I
will have to have a certificate from
you showing the length of time for
which I have been responsible for
Govt property used by the Company.

You can make a statement certifying
what the payrolls show. I do not
know what the payrolls show or
I could write the Certificate and
send it to you for your signature
