We are enclosing a copy of the Model Charter Membership List which indicates the form to be used in writing up the charter list of your club and also contains the form of the certificate which is to be executed by the President and Secretary of the new club. Three copies of the charter list are required. Use the attached three sheets for the first page of these lists.

Also you will find enclosed a list of major and minor classifications which will make it easy to select classifications for the charter list of your club and will insure proper terminology for each classification selected.
