Now comes the defendant, Phoeba Davis, for answer to the petition herein. Says that she has not sufficient knowledge or information upon which to find a belief, whether or not the Plaintiff, Ida Butler and J. F. Butler were married to each other on the 5th day of January 1903; or whether or not they have lived happily together until the day of 1 1906. She denies that on the day of 1906 or on divers other days, unlawfully or illegally, persuaded or allowed the Plaintiff's husband to have carnal or sexual intercourse with her; denies that he J. F. Butler had sexual or carnal intercourse with her at all; and denies thus by otherwise, or anywise at all, or persuasions, alienated the affections of John F. Butler, Plaintiff's husband, from the Plaintiff, to the extent that he said J. F. Butler has left his
