This cause coming to be heard on the motion of the defendant, Walter S. Harkins, to quash the <sup>execution</sup> ~~return~~ herein attempted to be issued in favor of Edward Merritt, Administrator of the estate of L. M. Dotson, deceased, and upon the affidavit of said defendant, Walter S. Harkins, therewith filed. Thereupon came the plaintiff in said execution, Edward Merritt, Administrator as aforesaid, by W. W. Williams, his Attorney of record, who stated that he had examined the records of the Floyd Circuit Court, but no execution had been issued on the said judgment for more than seven years next preceding January 25, 1916, and that the said execution so attempted to be issued is barred by the seven years "Statute of Limitations," as to the defendant, Walter S. Harkins.

Therefore it is considered and adjudged by the court that the motion of said defendant, Walter S. Harkins be and the same is hereby sustained, and said execution is here adjudged to be and the same is now quashed.
