On or about the 18th day of October 1884
he heard a conversation between the Plff
herein John G. Jones and the Deft herein
A. J. Surber at the Bonanza Hotel in the
town of Prestonsburg Ky in which conversation
the Deft A. J. Surber agreed and promised to pay
to the said John G. Jones a draft for one
hundred and fifty dollars, ^{the amt of the draft is not positively} which had been
drawn on said Surber in favor of said John
by James Greer Deputy for said A. J. Surber
United States Marshall for the District of
Kentucky, the said draft had been protested
In said conversation said Surber requested said
Jones to hold the draft up until he returned to
Louisville Ky and then send it up and he would
pay it.
