By the terms of said contract the petitioner Lucy Cassady became the owner of the said 7 yoke of cattle & hogs, 2 cows, and calf and plow machine mentioned in said contract and the same was held by the deft Henry L. Cassady in trust for and as the agent of the petitioner Lucy Cassady, on and after August 28 1899 and was hers the said Lucy Cassady's property at the time this suit was filed, at the order of attachment herein was placed in the hands of the officers to execute and at the time of the levy of the attachment herein and is and was her property at the time of the alleged acts complained of in the Petition. She says that the yoke of white fided cattle, the yoke of red and white fided cattle, the yoke of white fided cattle named Buck and Ball, the yoke of cattle both named ball, the yoke of white fided cattle named Peter & John the yokes & chains & grabs, the gray mare the black cow with a white back the red dehorned cow and the red calf, the 3 spotted hogs and the other hogs and the bald faced steer and the sulky plow levied on was part of the personal property mentioned in the said writing number 1.

By the deed marked No 2 defendant Henry L. Cassady conveyed to her Lucy Cassady on August the 28<sup>th</sup> 1899 the following real estate which is levied on by the order of attachment issued in this action to wit.

One tract of land on the cold water far of Rockcassid creek containing 121 acres and bounded as follows to wit calls <sup>and</sup> meets and bounds here given land
