The Defendants John W. Hudson - for Reply
to the Answer of the Defendants; State that
it is true and he admits that the Defs.
Sayre, made a Settlement of his ac-
count as Guardian, the Sayre & Co. State D.
and that in said Settlement; said Guardian
was credited with the Sum
of Four hundred and Sixty Four
Dollars and nine cents; But he
denies that one third, or \$134⁶⁹ of the
same was or is chargeable to this Plaintiff
on account of Disbursements made
for him - But that the only amount for
which the Plaintiff is entitled to a credit
is the amount State in his Petition
Further answering he states that it is true
and he admits; that upon the 11th day of
march 1875 said Defs. had a Settlement
with Lewis P. Mayo, a Judge of the
Hyde County Court; and that said Defs.
was in said Settlement allowed a credit
for Expenditures the Sum of Five
hundred and 31 Dollars and ³⁸/₁₀₀ Cents.
But he denies that one third or ¹⁷¹⁶/₁₀₀₀
is chargeable to this Plaintiff, for Expendit-
ures made for him, or to any other Sum-
or amount except that for which said
Defendant has credited; in said Petition
