The defendant, Colonel May, having filed a petition asking that the Administrator pay into the hands of Jo. M. Davidson, guardian for Colonel May, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) for the purpose of enabling the said guardian, Jo. M. Davidson, to place Colonel May in school and to defray the expenses incident thereto, the Court upon consideration of said motion considers and adjudges that the Administrator, Thomas Wilkinson, be, and he is hereby directed to pay over to Jo. Davidson, guardian, is hereby authorized and empowered to apply the same in payment of expenses and tuition and clothing for said Colonel May while so in school, but in doing so he will pay the same from month to month and will report his acts under this order to the next term of the court.
