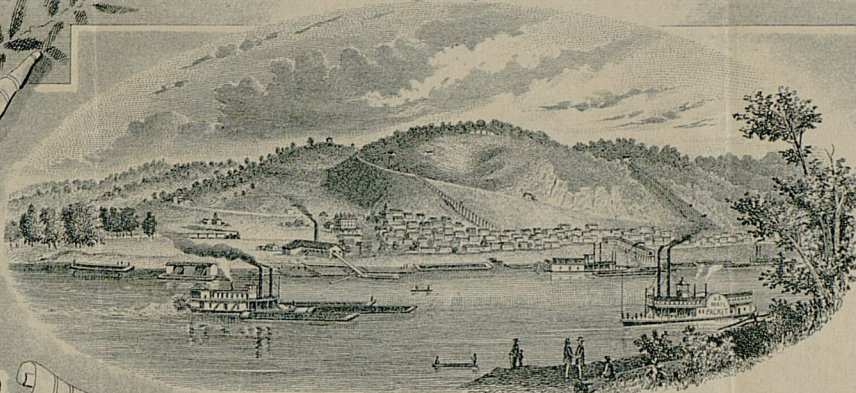
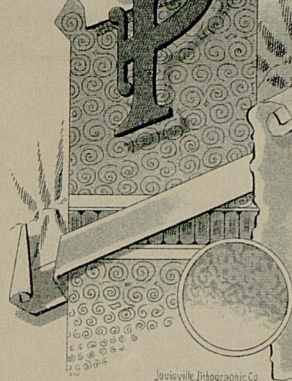

Gentlemen: --
