

THIS DEED OF CONVEYANCE, Made and entered into by and between Hiram S. Harris, unmarried, of Prestonsburg, Kentucky, party of the first part, and Big Sandy Railway Company, Incorporated, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) dollars, payment of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part hereby sells, conveys, assigns and transfers unto the said Big Sandy Railway Company, that certain ferry, right, privilege, easement, estate and property in the ferry at the upper end of Prestonsburg, in Floyd County, Kentucky, the same purchased by him from Reuben Clark, together with the boats, rope and other equipment pertaining to said ferry, as now owned and possessed by the said Hiram S. Harris, and as acquired by him in his purchase from the said Ruben Clark and grant to him of the franchise by the Floyd County Court, which said franchise and license therefor is hereby assigned and transferred to the said Big Sandy Railway Company; together with any and all rights acquired under said purchase for the use of banks on either side of Big Sandy River. For more particular description, reference is had to the Deed of Conveyance made by the said Reuben Clark to Hiram S. Harris, delivery whereof has been made by the said Hiram S. Harris to Big Sandy Railway Company.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the Big Sandy Railway Company, successors and assigns.
