Election of Sec.
The Faculty met, according to resolution. After roll call and reading of minutes, R.M. Roark was selected Secy. for current collegiate year.

Committee on Post-grad. Deg.
President Patterson called the attention of the Faculty to the matter of class-marching. Mr. J.P. Nelson read a resolution (No. 12, file B) to the effect that a committee be appointed by the President to report at the next regular meeting as to post-graduate degrees. The resolution prevailed, and the President appointed Messrs. White, Nelson, Roark, Neville, Anderson, Keath, Garman, and Mathews as the committee.

Fixing day another of meet.
Mr. Nelson read a second resolution (No. 13, file B) to the effect 1. that during the college year 1894-5 the regular meetings of the Faculty be held on the first Friday in each month, at 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ a.m.; and 2. that when the Faculty is in session, each professor shall make provision for at least the good order, if not for the instruction of his class during his absence from the class room. The resolution was adopted.

Petition for Monday as Holiday.
The Secy. read a petition (No. 13a, file B) from J.R. Dean, and others, students of the college, respectfully asking that Monday be given as a holiday, instead of Saturday. The petition was referred to Messrs. Shackelford, Keath, Nelson as a committee, to

consider the matter and report at next regular meeting.

Mr. Nelson presented a request - without comment or recommendation - from the Football Team, asking to be allowed to play Oct. 27 & 29 at Butler University, Ind., and at the State University of Ind. Mr. Anderson, seconded by Col. Swigert, moved to allow the request. After some discussion the following resolution by Dr. Shackelford was adopted: - "That in view of information received by the Faculty that the opinion of the Board of Trustees is decidedly against granting such requests as that made by the base team, we decline to grant their petition to go to Ind. the last of this month to play."
