Dear Father.

Your letter announcing your safe arrival home came to hand yesterday. I was a little fearful when you left that you would not stand the trip very well.

I am very glad to learn that you found all well when you got home.

Will get back from Genl Atchison on the day that you and be left there.

Our Court adjourned on Friday and left about half or more of the business undisposed of. This is a great misfortune to us, but cannot be helped. The next week Mr. Carr went out to Oskaloosa and I to Hiawatha in Brown County. I got home on Thursday
