

This Indenture made and entered into this first day
of April one thousand eight hundred and seven. Between
Wm. Richards of Scott County and State of Kentucky
of the one part and Thornton Pryor of the same county
and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said
William Richards for and in consideration of the
sum of one thousand Dollars the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth grant bar-
gain and sell unto the said Thornton Pryor and
his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or
parcel of land, situate lying and being in the said
County of Scott on the waters of McCannell's Run
and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at
a buckeye in the lane thence No 83 degrees West
112 poles to a white oak ash and white oak and
hickory, thence South 08 degrees West 96 poles to
two white oaks and ash on the side of a small
road, thence South 46 degrees East 206 poles
to a boxelder and buckeye on the side of a
road near Whites, thence No 45 degrees East
54 poles to a hickory in said road thence No
5 degrees East 127 poles to the Beginning of
together with all and singular the premises
and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining and the revenues, remainders,
profits hereof and every part and parcel
thereof
