## FOREWORD

A review of the accreditation of elementary schools of the state for the school year 1969-70 continues to indicate that major progress is being made in most areas of elementary education.

Progress in the various areas reflects the great concern that elementary personnel have for meeting the individual needs of children. The importance of this concern is shown by improvement in the following areas:

- ✓Expansion of curriculum offerings
- ✓Increase of experimental programs
- ✓Greater variety of teaching procedures and techniques
- ✓The use of various teaching aids has greatly increased during recent years

Elementary schools with eight or more teachers are classified as Extended, Standard, Basic or Approved. Appropriate standards and criteria adopted by the State Board of Education are written into regulations for accrediting the elementary schools.

You will note that there are still relatively few schools classified as Extended but you will also observe a gradual increase in the number of Standard schools and a slight decrease in the number of Basic schools.

We trust this bulletin will be helpful to both elementary school personnel and others striving for a qualitative elementary school for each child in Kentucky.

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR 1969-70

There were 1,056 elementary schools accredited by the State Board of Education during the school year 1969-70. Of this number 713 were under the control of the county school districts and 216 were under the control of the independent districts. Nineteen (19) were state or federal and 108 were private schools.

Table I below shows the number of accredited elementary schools classified according to the type of control for five years from 1965-70.

The total number of elementary schools operating in Kentucky including all of the elementary schools of seven teachers and below as well as the 1,056 accredited schools, numbered 1,489 schools. Of this number, there were 111 one-teacher schools compared to 166 one-teacher schools last year.

The number of pupils enrolled in the accredited elementary schools continues to grow. This year there were 476,502 pupils enrolled in these schools for the year. Of this number 325,988 were in the schools under the control of the county school districts, and 102,890 were enrolled in the schools under the control of the independent school districts. The others were enrolled in schools which were operated by state or federal authorities or in the private schools.
