Dear Sir:

I have yours of March 29th, returning file in the case of Charles Wilson v. L & N, in Breathitt Circuit Court. I note your statement that this suit was dismissed settled at the July Term, 1914. I have nothing in my file to indicate that such disposition had been made of the suit, my last letter to you on the subject having been written apparently under date of July 6, 1914, and your last letter to me on the subject bears date July 4, 1914.

I do not find that I have ever had any report of proceedings showing that the case was dismissed settled. Please also let me know whether by the expression "dismissed settled" you mean that the defendant paid the plaintiff anything in satisfaction of his claim. In other words, kindly ~~let~~ let me have a full report of the case, so that I may know how to advise the Louisville office.
