Dear Sir:

I have your letter, stating that you had instructed our Local Attorneys to take up with the attorney of Mr. W.M. Hall the matter of consideration named in the deed for original right of way covering additional right of way required. I attach hereto a deed covering a small portion of additional right of way required for waste bank from his property. I would suggest that the attorneys offer Mr. Hall \$41.00 consideration for the 0.41 acre required, and that if not accepted by Mr. Hall, we go ahead and use the property under our original deed which gives us such rights and that the matter of payments for the same remain in abeyance.
