Dear Judge:

Referring to the fire claim of J.E. Hargis v. L & E, upon which a judgment was recovered by the plaintiff for \$57.00 in the Breathitt Quarterly Court and an appeal afterwards taken by the plaintiff to the Breathitt Circuit Court, upon which summons was issued March 20, 1914, will you please advise me whether this case has ever been tried out in the Circuit Court or compromised or settled since it reached the Circuit Court. My files covering the various Hargis suits have become somewhat mixed and confused, but I have nothing apparently to indicate that this particular case has ever been finally disposed of. I note at the close of your Docket Report of the above suit the statement - "Unless her attorneys mend their holds, we ought to be able to keep the case from the jury, if the court will give us the law", etc.
