I have your wire from Whitesburg, of the 14th instant, advising me that the Indictments against the L. & E. Railway Co. for obstructing roads will not be tried at this term of the Letcher Circuit Court.

I have also received your recent favor notifying me that the attorneys representing the lien claimants in the various cases of that character pending in Perry County have agreed not to agitate or prosecute their claims any further until the Petition for Rehearing in the Grigsby case has been disposed of by the Court of Appeals.

I am also in receipt of your favor of the 14th instant, advising me of the action of the County Judge of Perry County in the matter of the tax suit instituted by the Sheriff against the L. & E.
