Replying to your letter of the 10th inst asking for statement showing the present status on right of way matters on Yont's Fork, Potter's Fork and Bottom Fork spurs, I beg to reply as follows:

YONTS FORK SPUR:

1.10 acre parcel. In litigation in suit of L. & E. Ry Co. vs. John Bently, &c., now pending in Letcher Circuit Court. Case now on appeal in Letcher Circuit Court. On March 31, 1913, John Bently and wife compromised with the Company and executed deed which is now in your possession. A. K. Lusk, who had a lease on a small portion of this parcel, has not been settled with. However, this will be done shortly. The Consolidation Coal Co. who owns right of way under mineral deed will execute release to you for this parcel upon final closing of right of way matters.

7.54 acres parcel, owned by Consolidation Coal Co. I assume that the foregoing area is correct as it so appears on blue print furnished by by your company. This parcel will be conveyed to you by Consolidation Coal Company upon final closing of right of way matters.

.64 acre parcel. In litigation in suit of L. & E. Ry Co. vs. John Venters heirs, &c. A 5-6 interest in this parcel was conveyed to your company by commissioner's deed of date February 18, 1914. This deed is now in your possession. You have requested that suit be brought to correct certain mistakes in description in this deed which as yet has not been done.
