Defendants, Lexington & Eastern Railway Company and Louisville Nashville Railroad Company, move the Court to Strike from plaintiff's Petition hereinafter all of the following portions thereof, viz:-

(1) The following words, on the 3rd page of said Petition, to-wit:- "Without exercising their right of eminent domain or by contract with this plaintiff for the right of way through her lands or by condemnation proceedings and".

(2) Also, the following words, on the same page, to-wit:- "notwithstanding the fact that the boundary of land so taken by the defendants formed a part of the yard and lawn within 30 feet of the door sill of the home of this plaintiff where she had lived and resided for the last 25 years;"

(3) Also, the following words, "and irreparable", on the 4th page of said Petition.

(4) Also, the following words, on the said 4th page of the Petition, to-wit:- "That they have constructed their said right of way in front of the home of this plaintiff and between her said home and the public highway and at the place that she has always used as a passway and road from her home to said public highway and that the only place that it is possible for this plaintiff to go to and from the public highway in such a way".
