V. MOTION TO HAVE WARRANT OF AUTHORITY.

Defendant, Lexington & Eastern Railway Company,
moves the Court to require the plaintiff herein to show whether
or not the present suit or proceeding has been instituted by
or through him, with the sanction and approval or by the di-
rection of the State Supervisor or State Superintendent of
Revenue Agents in Kentucky.

Defendant states that under a rule adopted by
the State Auditor of Public Accounts and now in force in
the State of Kentucky, all suits of this character instituted
by Revenue Agents in the various counties of Kentucky are
required to be so instituted with the sanction and approval
and by the direction or with the consent of a State Supervisor
or State Superintendent of Revenue Agents who is appointed by
the State Auditor of Public Accounts and serves as such subject
to his control.
