Reserving its exceptions to the former rulings of the Court herein upon defendant's General Demurrer to the plaintiff's Petition and also upon the Demurrers of the plaintiff to the first three Paragraphs of defendant's original Answer herein of August 24, 1915, now comes the defendant, by leave of Court, and amends its said original Answer of August 24, 1915, and files the present Amended Answer as a substitute for said former Answer.

Defendant, Louisville & Nashville Railroad Company, for answer to said original Petition of June 19, 1915, states that it has not knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief that Kuzmas Lakotich was a citizen of Austria, Hungary, and denies that he was, at the time of his death, or ever at any time a resident of Letcher County or of the State of Kentucky and, for the want of knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief, defendant denies that on the 17th day of October 1914, or at any time, said Kuzmas Lakotich died intestate or died at all in said County or State, or elsewhere.

Defendant states that it is true, as appears from the certified copy of an order made by the County Court of Letcher County, on or about June 7th, 1915, that the Judge of said Court attempted to appoint the plaintiff, Wm. C. Young, administrator of said decedent, Kuzmas Lakotich, and that said Young
