Your letter of March 9th file 88269 and Judge Wilson's letter of the 8th, case of Morgan Pelfry. The paymaster wrote E. C. Hyden Attorney at Jackson on January 25th as follows:-

"Referring to your letter of the 18th inst., addressed to Mr Seargeant Superintendent Ravenna, Ky., in regard to \$25.20 wages due Morgan Pelfry, as time for section laborer at Oakdale, Ky., in October 1916.
