The Faculty were convened to act upon the petition of Messrs. J. T. Geary, J. T. Davis, E. M. Muir, R. R. Clark, C. A. Blase and Chas. Woolley, students, to be allowed to take part in the base-ball contests. There was a preliminary discussion of the grade standard or test to be applied to those seeking admission to the Athletic Association for regular team play. The order of the Board of Trustees of the College, and action of the Faculty in former cases were read. It was finally ordered that a grade of $12\frac{1}{2}$ - ~~average~~ - should be the standard of proficiency that must be attained by all students below the grade of freshman, applying for admission to the Athletic Association, before the Faculty would even consider their applications, and that even then the matter of admission shall be subject to the action of the Faculty.

Mr. W. K. Patterson moved to condition Clark's playing upon his dropping shop-work. His motion did not reach a vote, on account of its being shown meanwhile that Clark had not the requisite $12\frac{1}{2}$ average grade. Mr. Davis was admitted to play. Mr. Woolley was admitted to play. Mr. ? was admitted, as being a student in the College proper.
