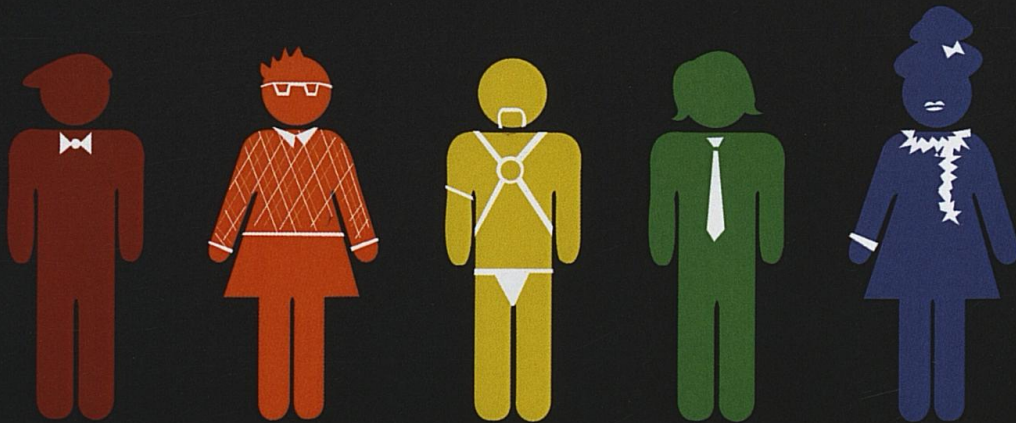

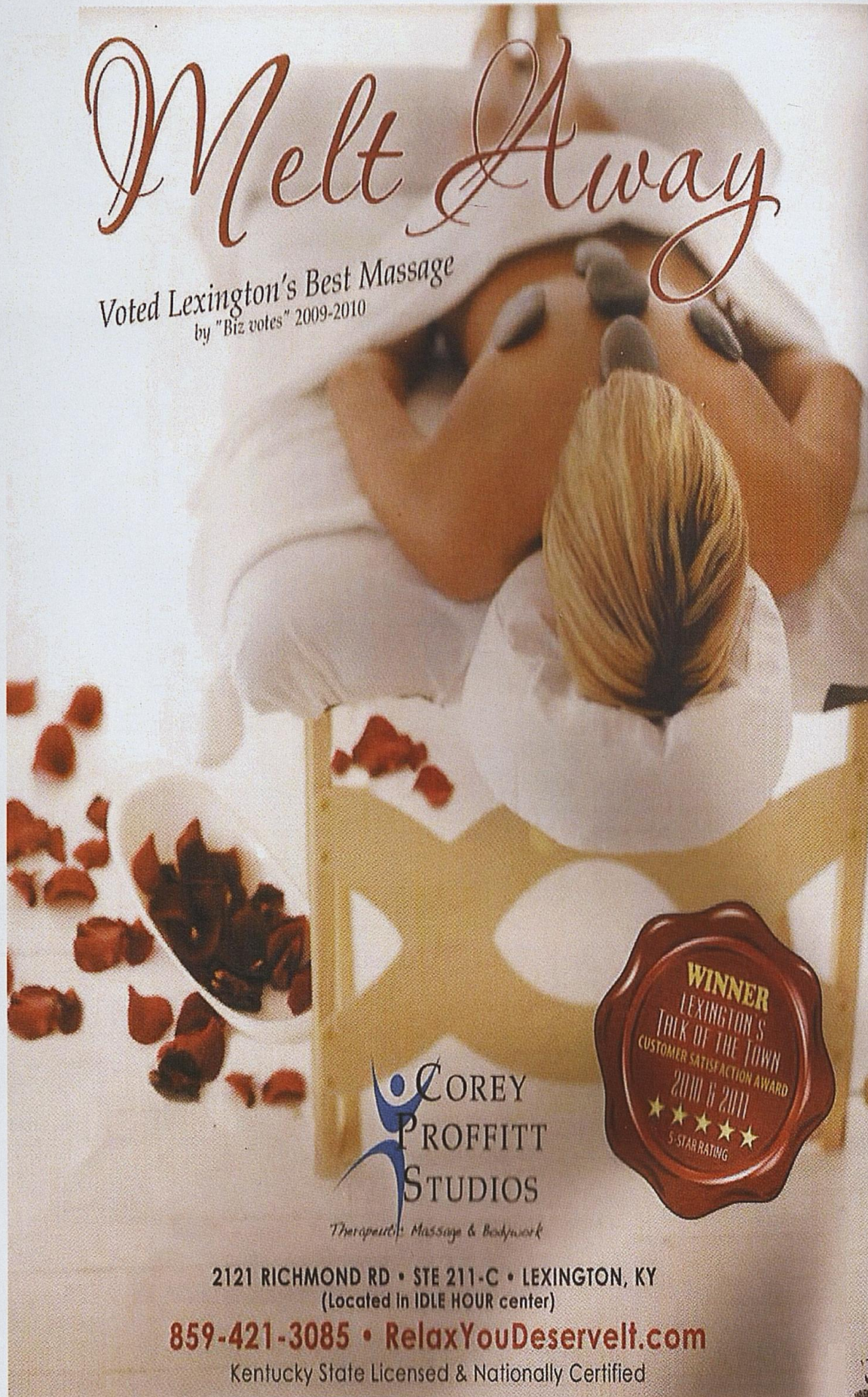

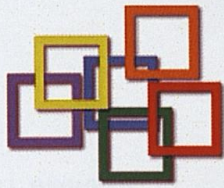

On behalf of the Commonwealth, I am pleased to welcome you to the Bluegrass.

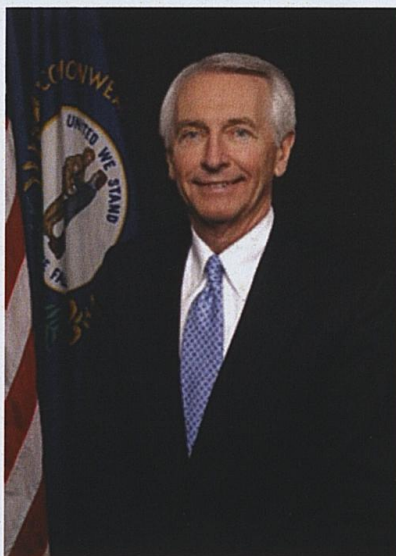

Dear Pride Attendees,
