Shore drive etc. We think

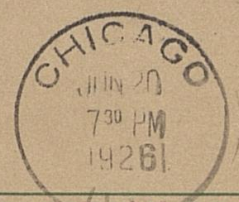
we saw the big guy ^{congress} ~~frankly~~
