

H. Clay acting for and in behalf of Saml  
Moale Trustee of the Purvianees agrees with Richard  
Merewether & John Hughes to sell them all of the  
settlements and preemptions of the two Prallits in  
Jefferson County or what the said Hughes & William  
Merewether reside not heretofore sold by H. Pur-  
viance, or others acting for him, or under the  
decree of the Fed. Court, which part remaining  
vacant & unsold is supposed to contain  
about nine hundred acres. The said Clay  
agrees that the part hereby sold shall be  
stricken off to the said Richard Merewether &  
John Hughes at a public sale what he  
contemplates having made under the decree  
of the Fed. Court, and that the Commissioners  
shall convey the same to the said R. Merewether  
and John Hughes according to the terms and  
directions of the Fed. Court. In consideration  
of the above sale the said R. Merewether & Hughes  
have this day paid me <sup>eight hundred and two</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>two</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>seven</sup> <sup>dollars</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>also</sup> <sup>pay</sup> <sup>eighty</sup> <sup>five</sup> <sup>dollars</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>five</sup> <sup>cents</sup> <sup>more</sup> <sup>making</sup>  
nine hundred & thirty dollars and fifty cents. Witness my hand & seal
