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This Indenture made and entered into
this ninth day of May 1839 by and between James

and William Prather, Charles M. Way and John
Joyce of the second part Witnesseth that the
said Prather for and in consideration of the
sum of One Dollar natural love and other good
cause's him here unto moving hath bargained
and sold and doth hereby bargain sell and
convey to the said Prather, Way and Joyce the
following pieces of real estate lying and situated
in the City of Louisville and its vicinity First a
house and lot on the north side of main street
between fifth and sixth cross streets known as No. 5
Prathers Row and at ^{present} occupied by and under
lease to George Winston & Co Second a lot of land
on Green Street bounded as follows: Beginning at the
south east corner of Green and fourth streets
thence with Green street east sixty feet and
running back the afore said width of sixty feet
with fourth street and finding on said fourth
street One hundred and fifty feet to an alley
being part of the square known as Prather
square Third One hundred and three feet on
the eastern side of fourth cross street
between Green and Walnut streets and running
back on east the afore said width of One hun-
dred and three feet two hundred feet to an alley
on which is the Old mansion house of Thomas
Prather deceased bounded on the north by a
lot owned by Catharine C. Prather and on the
south by a lot owned by Matilda Nicholas

the life estate of the said James of in and
to the house and lot on the west side of
fourth cross street where he now resides Fifth
