

Louisville June 29th 1846

I hereby appoint Wm Prather my attorney in fact with full power to collect rents that are now due or may hereafter become due, to give leases for a period not exceeding one year, to appoint agents at his discretion for the purposes above mentioned, to pay my debts and interests upon them, to pay calls on notes in any Bank and to renew such notes when necessary, to sell and convey two lots on the Prather ^{square} one fronting on Green St 75 feet now vacant the other on third st fronting 51 1/2, and to make deeds and sign my name for the purpose to the purchasers of the above lots and in general to pay taxes and other charges upon my property to make necessary repairs and to perform such other acts as may be necessary in his judgment to the preservation of my property and to putting it in an order to be rented
