

This Indenture, made this Twenty third day of September one thousand eight hundred and  
thirty two between William Sampson and Chaney his wife of the City of Louisville  
Jefferson County and State of Kentucky of the one part and Rufus Somerby  
of the same place -

of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said

William Sampson - for and in consideration of the sum of  
Five hundred and Sixty dollars lawful money of the United States to him  
in hand paid -

the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, and sold, aliened, released, enfeoffed, conveyed, and confirmed; and  
by these presents, doth grant, bargain and sell, alien, release, enfeoff, convey and confirm, unto the said Rufus Somerby

and to his --- heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land, with all the appurtenances, lying and being in the  
said City of Louisville on the North side of Broadway or Prather St<sup>t</sup>, between  
Jackson and Hancock Streets; and beginning for the same, thirty five feet from the  
North East corner of Jackson St<sup>t</sup> & Broadway, and running thence Eastwardly and bending  
on the North side of Broadway twenty feet, thence Southwardly at right angles, one hundred  
and thirty seven feet six inches, to a twenty foot alley; thence Westwardly and bending on said alley  
Twenty feet, thence Southwardly at right angles one hundred & thirty seven feet six inches to Broad  
way the place of beginning: it being lots No<sup>o</sup> 87 and 88, and known by those numbers on Sampsons Subdi  
visions of twenty acre lot No<sup>o</sup> 2  
and all the estate, right, title, claim, interest, and fee, of him the said William Sampson -

of, in and to the same: To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land, with all the appurtenances, unto the said Rufus Somerby


and to his heirs and assigns, to their only proper use and behoof, forever. And the said William Sampson doth
