

This Indenture made this eighteenth day of June in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
twenty seven between Charles Thomson and Sally his wife
of the County of Scott and State of Kentucky of the one
part and James M Bradford of the County of Franklin
and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth That
the Said Charles Thomson and Sally his wife for and in
consideration of the sum of three thousand Seventy four
dollars and forty Cents Current money of Kentucky to them
in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
Hath granted bargained and sold and by these Presents
doth grant Bargain Sell and convey unto the Said
James M Bradford his heirs and assigns forever all that
Tract or parcel of land wherou Said Bradford now
resides situate and being between the waters of north &
South Elk horn (it being a part of Steels Preemption of one
thousand acres) containing Two hundred & Ninety acres
two rods and sixteen poles and bounded as follows, Viz.
Beginning at a white ash on Steels original line corner to
William Fowle and running with said Fowles line North
one and quarter degrees West ~~one hundred~~ and ninety poles
and Seven links to a planted stone on Silas Douthits line
Hence with the said line North eighty eight degrees East
one hundred and eighty two poles and thirteen links to a
planted stone corner to said Douthet on Steels original
line and with the same South two degrees East one hundred
and ninety three poles to a stake in the carters field
(it being Steels Preemption corner) eight feet south of a small
black locust marked as a pointer thence South Eighty eight
degrees west with Steels original line one hundred and
eighty four poles to the beginning Together with all and singular
the premises with the appertaining therunto Belonging
