By "Chain bearing" is meant a Gunter Chain of 100 links, or 4 rods.

This Indenture made this the first day of October 1878 by and between S. W. Paine and M. A. Paine his wife and Elizabeth A. Paine of the first part and Henry C. McDowell of the second part, all of the County of Franklin & State of Kentucky; Witnesseth, that the parties of the first part for, and in Consideration of, Six thousand, seven hundred and fifty dollars Cash, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold. and by these presents do sell and convey to the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever the following described tract of land, to wit; Begin at a stone, corner to W. J. and Waller Lewis, on the Frankfort and Georgetown pike, near Providence baptist Church, Thence S. 67 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. along the middle of the pike 8 $\frac{29}{100}$ chains to a point in said pike between N. C.
