Memorandum of agreement between Wm Cassius Goodloe and  
H. C. McDowell witnesses. Goodloe agrees to breed his two mares "Jay"  
by George Wilkes - dam by Pilot, and "Attention" by "Onward" dam  
by Alexander, Abdallah, to "Dictator" on the shares. Goodloe is  
to keep mares and foals at his cost until weaned in Fall  
of 1887. After weaning McDowell is to take the foals and keep  
them at his cost. Neither of the foals are to be sold before  
weaning without consent of both parties. After weaning  
whenever a bona fide offer is made for one or both foals  
which one of the parties to this agreement is willing to ac-  
cept, and the other is not, then the party so refusing  
is to take the foal or foals at the price offered, paying  
to other party one half of said sum. The party thus  
paying, becoming the sole owner of said foal or foals.  
After the foals become yearlings, the cost of keeping is to be borne  
jointly by the parties to this agreement.
