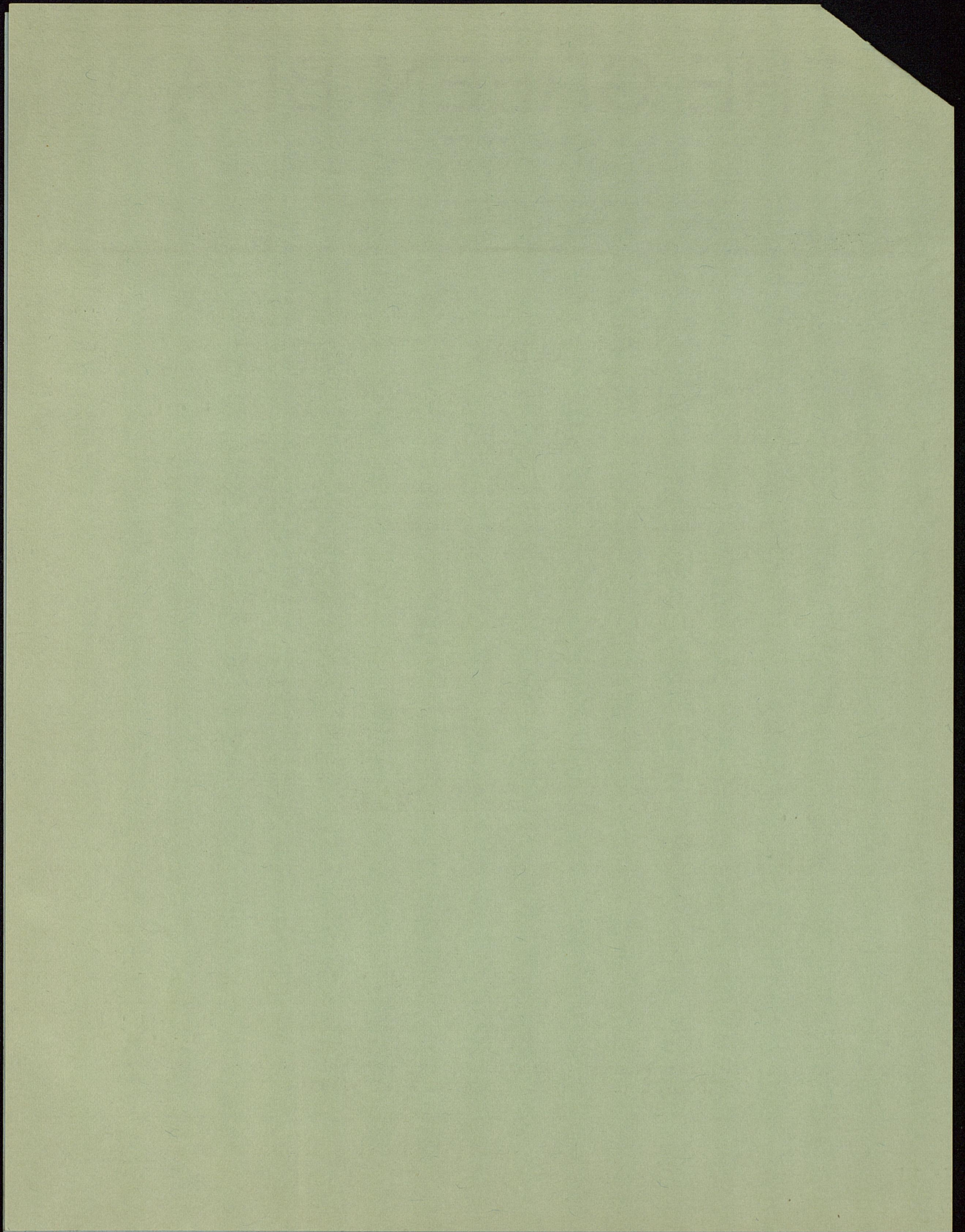

Heat Control

Under rules sent out by the U.S. Department of Energy, thermostats in most UK buildings are required to be set no lower than 78°F for cooling and no higher than 65°F for heating. To this date, libraries have not been exempt from these regulations. Until and unless such exemption is granted special care will have to be taken to monitor the conditions of books and other materials in the libraries.

Annual Steam Shut-down

The steam in M.I. King Library will be shut-off for equipment maintenance and repairs during the period 9-23 August inclusive. The principal effect of this will be the lack of hot water during the period. Another possible effect is a noticeable drop in temperature in the library, as steam is used in regulating the cooling system.
