



Parish of Terrebonne La
Aug 13th 1865

I do hereby constitute and appoint my son
Wart Gibson of Woodford County, Kentucky, my
true and lawful attorney with full power to
sell, convey and deliver for me and in my name,
with full guarantee, and to receive the consideration
for the same - all that tract of land situate
and being in the city of Lexington, Kentucky and
bounded as follows; to wit; Beginning at a stone
on 2nd Street, corner of Geo. W. Sutton's present
residence formerly belonging to Tobias Gibson,
thence at right angles to said street to the corner
of said Sutton's carriage-house, thence on a straight
line along the line of said Sutton and
to corner of lot formerly belonging to said
Tobias Gibson and now owned by Hamilton,
thence along the line of said Hamilton to the line
of lot now owned by L. M. Bush to 2nd street and
thence along that street to the stone corner - the
place of beginning, being a part of a tract of land sold
by L. B. Smith & wife to said Gibson 1st Oct. 1849 as
per Deed Book, No 26, page 108, of the Fayette County
Court.
