W.G. Campbell  
Case of discipline

1<sup>st</sup> The case of W.G. Campbell charged with handling cadet rifles roughly, and failure to go to the guard house when directed to do so, while at Chattanooga.

Prof. Roark moved that Sergeant W.G. Campbell be reduced to ranks, and that he be put in arrest for the remainder of the term.

Case of discipline

2<sup>nd</sup> The case of Thos. A. Jones, charged with failure to report for squad-drill on 2 occasions.

The faculty learned incidentally that Mr. Jones habitually disregards his military duties, whereupon

The following was offered: viz.,

Resolved - That cadet T.A. Jones, be placed and kept in arrest during the remainder of the term, that he be required to make good all his military delinquencies at such times and places as Major Carpenter may direct.

That he be required to wear the full uniform each school day and attend strictly to all military duties, including every Chapel service.
