

Dean Miller reported that two seniors would probably have sufficient credits to graduate in December 1912, thus completing the course in three and a half years, and omitting the required English lectures in the spring. Dean Miller reported a noticeable tendency on the part of some students to forge ahead of their classes and thus undermine class unity. With unanimous consent President Barker referred this question to the Committee of Deans for further consideration and formal report. Adjourned.
