The story of his life is one of great courage and almost unbelievable sacrifice to bring Christianity and hope to the verminfested, sin-alden slums of his native Japan. Even tuberculosis and trachoma, a serious eye disease which almost bilinded him, did not stop him in his unting work.

Dr. Daniel A. Poling, editor of the Christian Herald and speaker at the dedication of UK's Memorial Coliseum, named Kagawa as one of the two men who will decide the fate of Japan. The other is Emport Hirohito.

The importance of Dr. Kagawa's current visit to America has lob been stressed by Dr. E. Stanley Jones, who says, "... he can be a bridge of understanding between Japan and America." As future leaders, students should take advantage of this chance to hear a man who is exerting such a powerful influence in the effort for world peace.


UK Spirit Impresses UC
